

Thomas College Auditorium Fact Sheet

(voice/data/video system items underlined)

Lobby/Halls/Other:

- 40'X30' lobby with bench seating near windows
- self-service coat room
- 24'x16' skylight
- wall mounted TV with student events channel
- Windows-based terminal for internet & email access
- a pay phone and a house phone
- covered glass walkway to lobby
- south hallway, two 16' built-in benches
- east hallway, restrooms
- fully air-conditioned building
- kitchenette operated by food service
- access through back hallway to gym lobby

Class Rooms:

- 2 – 34'X24' rooms
- operable partition
- capacity of each room, 35 - 30"X60"tables, (70 chairs total)
- electrical projection screen
- wall mounted TV with satellite, auditorium, local VCR/DVD inputs, and potential cable TV
- laptop (signed out from Library)
- portable LCD projector (signed out from Library)
- 70 electrical and data ports in tables for laptops
- wall mounted combination black and marker boards
- two small storage rooms

Auditorium:

- •301 seats: 116 seats with tablets, 90 seats with data jacks and an electrical port for half (45)
- 8 microphones on stage/ 2 in audience
- 3 ceiling/wall mounted speakers designed for voice
- 1 wireless hearing assistance set
- ceiling mounted projection screen operated by a hand-held remote on the stage
- ceiling mounted LCD projector
- ability to use VCR, DVD, laptop, future visual presenter, and overhead on the stage
- ability to use VCR, DVD, laptop, future visual presenter from the control room
- ability to project via LCD projector

- ability to project to all TVs on campus
- ability to project to a van outside the auditorium
- ability to record audio/video from the control room
- a place for at least 2 cameras outside the control room
- lectern to accommodate multimedia presentation
- access to the Internet from the stage for the presenter
