



I am pleased and proud to share this combined magazine and annual report. It is a busy time here on campus, and we are celebrating many accomplishments!

This year marks our 125th anniversary, and if you braved the cold temperatures on Homecoming and Family Weekend, you likely saw the anniversary video that highlights the history of Thomas from our roots on Main Street, our move to Silver Street, and our expansion to our current location on West River Road. If you missed the video, I encourage you to visit our website and follow us on social media. You can view the video and learn more about our inspiring faculty, staff, and students.

From a financial perspective, Thomas has—for 28 consecutive years—closed our books well in the black. Once again, the Lunder Scholars Golf Invitational raised a record amount of money for scholarships, and I am delighted to announce that we will be launching one of the very first varsity eSports programs in New England, thanks to the generosity of Bill and Joan Alfond. I am also excited to share that Thomas was awarded \$2.3 million from the U.S. Department of Education's Title III Strengthening Institutions Program, making Thomas the only private college in Maine to receive U.S. Department of Education funding from both Title III and the TRiO programs that support the aspirations of first-generation students from low-income families.

Also this Fall, we were thrilled to announce the opening of the Sukeforth Family Trail System! This network of trails provides a way to experience the natural beauty surrounding our campus, and we hope the Thomas family and the surrounding community will enjoy this feature for many years to come.


These updates are all wonderful acknowledgements of community confidence, and we are proud to carry such faith in our efforts.

Thomas College was founded in 1894, above the F. W. Woolworth Co. on Main Street in Waterville. At that time, it was unusual for women to pursue a college career—but, our students have never been afraid to be leaders. Since its beginning, the College has been coeducational and non-sectarian, and Thomas has stayed true to its roots as a college that helps prepare students for success in their professional careers.

Today, the College has grown into a thriving community of learners. We're proud of our history and are making big plans for our future.

What remains the same is our commitment to our students. We guarantee that you'll graduate with the education, professional skills, experience, network, and mentors to land a job and launch your career. Employers trust our college to produce interns and employees who can get big things done.

Kiest Business College is founded and located three floors above the F.W. Woolworth Co. in downtown Waterville. It is a non-sectarian, coeducational college dedicated to career training.

Kiest Business College, with a growing reputation, is purchased by William Morgan and renamed Morgan Business College.

Morgan Business College is purchased by Peterborough, New Hampshirebased railroad administrator John L. Thomas Sr., himself a graduate. The College is renamed Morgan-Thomas Business College.

Morgan-Thomas Business College is renamed Thomas Junior College.





The College moves to the former home of John Ware on Silver Street. In one of its two buildings, the College houses classrooms, a library, and administrative offices: the other includes a women's dormitory, dining room, a bookstore, and a student lounge. John L. Thomas, Jr. is named President.

Maine State Legislature grants the College the right to confer Associate in Arts and Associate in Secretarial science degrees.

Thomas College is re-chartered as a 501(c)(3) not-forprofit institution.

A second entryway is built to create easy access to the fields for community members; it is later named Vining Drive. The second phase of the Spann Student Commons is completed, including the Dog Pound - a student gathering place, café, pub, and campus store - as well as renovated student recreation space.





The Harold Alfond Academic Center opens - the second academic facility on campus. It includes the H. Allen Ryan School of Business, the Kenneth and Eva Green Library, Jeanie's Café, the Bert and Coral Clifford Financial Center, as well as classrooms, a student success center, study rooms, and faculty offices. The College also opens another residence hall, Henry and Ellen Hinman Hall. The main entrance is relocated to accommodate construction and is later named Sheridan Drive.


Thomas graduates its first Kiest-Morgan participants. The program is the College's formal, three-year undergraduate degree program.

Doug admits that he was persistent in his courting of Colleen. "I held a work-study job in the cafeteria and kept


insisting on seeing her student ID," he laughs. "I wanted to know her name."

Zeno and Melissa met in the Fall of their freshman year at Thomas. Zeno lived on the floor below Melissa. They were friends and involved is some of the same clubs. He remembers that he had decided that Melissa was "the one" because of his professor Philomena McPhee-Brown.

"Philomena was a matchmaker," said Zeno. "One day, when I was student teaching, she dropped in for a visit/observation and brought a surprise guest – Melissa."

More than 20 years after meeting and graduating from Thomas College, the Corrigans are happily married, have successful careers, and their daughter, Natalie, is now a Thomas College student.

Melissa and Zeno both remember the close community of Thomas College, and it's a big reason they loved attending the school.

"Staff and faculty made you feel like you were home," said Zeno. Melissa agreed saying, "There was a strong sense of a close community, and it seemed that you knew everyone."

Melissa and Zeno were both very involved on campus. Melissa was a resident assistant for two years, on Student Council all four years, and was a member of PBL. Zeno was part of the Alpha Gamma Delta fraternity, PBL member all four years and President for two, member of the Judicial Board, member of the Drama Club, and he ran the Thomas College pub for two years. Inside the classroom, they said the professors made all the difference.

"The professors at Thomas engaged their students and made learning fun," said Melissa. "They interacted with students

outside of the classrooms, and you could see them on campus for different functions. They were enthusiastic and passionate about what they taught."

Zeno cites many professors and staff that influenced him along the way, including Nelson Madore, Philomena McPhee-Brown, Moe St. Pierre, and Charlie from Security. But, there was one professor that became family – Roberta Tibbetts.

Roberta, who just celebrated her 47th work anniversary, was the first person Zeno met when he toured campus. "She made me feel like Thomas was the right place for me to be," said Zeno. "As I went through college, she became a mentor to me and someone that I could bounce my crazy ideas off from. After graduation, I taught with her at Mid-State College and became a part of her family."

"When we started our family, Roberta and David became Gram and Bumpa, and her two sons became uncles to our children. The Thomas family had afforded me the opportunity to become part of the Tibbetts' family. Through the years, she has inspired me and continues to be my mentor and at times my voice of reason," said Zeno.

Melissa also cherishes the relationship they've created with Roberta and David Tibbetts.

"They have always been there when we needed someone to take care of our kids when I had to be with Zeno for a business trip or dinner. With no immediate family in the area, they would take the kids and dogs," said Melissa. "Roberta has also provided emotional support and wisdom to both of us throughout the years."

Melissa and Zeno both left Thomas College and began their journey to successful careers in Maine. They said their time at Thomas prepared them well.

"The small, close-knit atmosphere allowed me to be involved in various clubs and activities that helped me gain more self-confidence, overcome shyness, and become a leader," said Melissa. "Management classes and psychology classes gave me a foundation to aid in my career in human resources."

"When I first entered college, I was overwhelmed by the amount of work that was given by the professors. I had to quickly learn how to manage my time, be organized, and to prioritize," said Melissa. "These are skills that I utilize today in my current position as human resource generalist with the State of Maine – Department of Corrections Service Center."

Zeno says, "The community atmosphere of Thomas College prepared me for my career success with emotional intelligence, social skills, and the opportunity to be a leader."

"Without this ability to lead at a young age, it would not have afforded me the chance to be in a management track program at Pine State Trading Company, now known as Core-Mark International," said Zeno.

After 23 years of working in various senior management positions, Zeno was recently promoted to New England Division President. Zeno manages \$1.6 billion in sales, approximately 700 employees, two distribution facilities, and five cross-stock facilities, servicing convenience stores from Buffalo, NY to Fort Kent, ME.

More than 20 years later, Melissa and Zeno's daughter, Natalie, is a marketing management student at Thomas College. Natalie also runs for the cross-country team and will graduate in May 2019.

Melissa and Zeno graduated as part of the 100th class at Thomas, and Natalie will graduate as part of the 125th class. "I enjoy that I am going to the same school that my parents went to," said Natalie.

The campus might look a lot different than when Natalie's parents attended, but it's still the same Thomas – plus, she even has some of the same professors her parents did, including Roberta Tibbetts, Dog Wallace, and Pat Karush.

Natalie echoes some of the same sentiments that her parents said about Thomas College's family oriented environment and the special people you meet when you're here.

"Thomas has changed my life by giving me the time and attention I need to succeed in school and to go places in life," said Natalie. "They have also helped me to create some pretty amazing connections throughout my time here. Thomas has given me a great group of friends, and my boyfriend is a graduate of Thomas as well."

Natalie likes to think they may be following in the same footsteps as her parents did. "Thomas truly is my family inside and out," said Natalie. "I can't imagine having a better school to be a part of my family."

President Laurie Lachance M.B.A. '92 led the group in wishing Peter a happy belated 85th birthday, and in thanking the repeat and new team sponsors, Senior VP of Advancement Bob Moore '79 relayed to the crowd a story of a recent visit with the Lunders. "With a goal to raise \$100,000 this year, Paula suggested that we aim to raise \$125,000 to mark the College's 125th anniversary," he recalled. "I suggested that I should have had her on our golf committee months ago!" Sure enough, with the Lunders generously matching net proceeds for the 15th consecutive year, more than \$260,000 was raised (a new record) and added to their endowed scholarship fund.

Proceeds from the golf tournament benefit the Lunder Scholars Endowment Fund, which provides crucial scholarship support for Maine students attending Thomas. Since 2002, the fund – established with the

Celebrating 125 Years

On Saturday, October 13, the College community celebrated the launch of the institution's 125th year.

With a crowd of more than 200 gathered, Senior VP of Advancement Bob Moore '79 introduced President Lachance M.B.A. '92, trustee Kelley Shimansky '89, and student-athlete Katie Taylor '19, who each reflected on the many ways in which Thomas has grown – yet the key ways in which it has remained the same.

"What we had, we had to build," said Kelley Shimansky, noting Thomas's small size during the 1980s, and reflecting on the engagement and camaraderie of students.

"When I think about 'appreciating today or the now," said Katie Taylor, "I think about how many students before me have had, and how many students after me will experience, these amazing moments that I have come to cherish. I don't think that I can thoroughly appreciate today, without those who have been so instrumental in my successes here, such as my professors, coaches, teammates, and friends." Taylor spoke immediately following her win as a member of the

field hockey team.

President Lachance remarked on the power of the community that makes Thomas the family that it is, and how instrumental it has been in helping students achieve personal and professional success for 125 years. "As we look to the future," she said, "we can continue to celebrate the achievements of our talented, hard-working, and caring students and alumni as they capitalize on gifts they have received from their incredible faculty members, coaches, and mentors." She also thanked the supporters in the crowd, including Doug and Rita Sukeforth, whose generosity helped to build a new campus trail system to enhance health, wellness, and safety.

The students, families, alumni, beloved faculty members, staff, and friends in attendance stayed for the Men's Soccer match against Husson, live music from the School Street Trio, delicious pizza thanks to a donation from Steel House Oven food truck, and an evening fireworks display over the Kennebec Savings Bank Turf Fields.








Thomas Athletics had one of its best starts in school history, thanks to a championship-filled fall season. Men's Soccer won their fifth North Atlantic Conference (NAC) Championship and competed in the NCAA Division III Tournament.

Field Hockey won its first NAC Championship in program history after an undefeated conference season and finished runner-up in the NECC Championship. Women's Soccer finished their conference season undefeated and entered the NAC Tournament as the number one seed before falling in the championship game. Golf returned to the NCAA level this season and the team competed in its first NAC Championship since 2009.

Along with the team success this year, Thomas student-athletes had some great individual success. Cross Country junior Jarrod Ottman won the first NAC Individual Championship and Player of the Year in program history. Women's Soccer freshman Katherine Hoving ranked third in the country with 27 goals on the season, the most goals in a season in program history, and was named NAC Rookie of the Year. Field Hockey's Kelci Faulkingham was named NAC Player of the Year, while Tiffany Weeks earned Defensive Player of the Year. Kyle Patterson was also named NAC Men's Soccer Rookie of the Year. The Terriers had 16 student-athletes named to All-Conference teams and also had two NAC Coaches of the Year in Field Hockey's Andrea Thebarge and Women's Soccer's Deb Biche-Labbe.

The Terriers were well represented in the NAC Weekly Awards all season long as well. Field Hockey had six different players earn Player of the Week and sweep all three awards (Player, Rookie, and Defensive Player) six times. Jarrod Ottman was named Runner of the Week five times, while Men's Soccer's Jonathan Dutka won Defensive Player of the Week three times. Overall, the Terriers have had 15 Players/Runners of the Week, 15 Rookies of the Week, and 13 Defensive Players of the Week.


