Application for Minor

Students interested in declaring a minor should complete this application with their Faculty Adviser. All fields must be complete for processing. Minors will be applied to the student's program sheet and will appear on a student's transcript, but not on the diploma. A complete list of minor requirements can be found in the College Catalog. A student can declare any major offered by The College unless otherwise indicated in the College Catalog. Adding a minor may result in additional credit hours and semesters to complete degree requirements.

The School of Business Minors consist of 18 credit hours and are available in the following disciplines: Accounting, Coaching, Communications, Cybersecurity, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Hospitality and Tourism Management, International Business, Information Technology Management, Management, Marketing, Project Management, Sport Management, and Sustainability Management.

The School of Arts and Sciences minors generally consist of 18 credit hours, 12 of which must be courses beyond core requirements and not already part of the student's program. Available minors are: Criminal Justice, English, Diversity, Environmental Science, Global Sustainability, Mathematics, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Forensic Psychology, Pre-Law, Science, Sociology, Writing.

The School of Education offers a minor in Education consisting of 18 credits hours.
