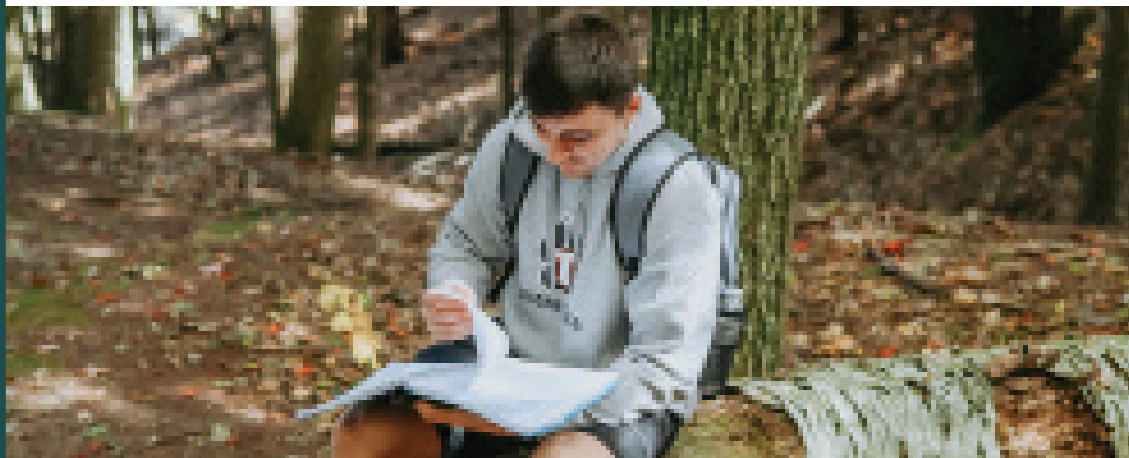

With your application to Thomas College, we'll automatically consider you for generous merit-based scholarships. Students seeking financial assistance other than merit-based scholarships should file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
