- ✓ College Essay and SAT and / or ACT
(optional)

3. BEGIN THE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS:

With your application to Thomas College, we'll automatically consider you for generous merit-based scholarships. Students seeking financial assistance other than merit-based scholarships should file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

AFTER YOU APPLY

Check your admission status. We'll notify you of our decision by **December 31** if you apply by **December 15**, or within about two weeks of receiving your application. If you've already been accepted to Thomas College, pay your deposit.
