Thomas College's International Thomas Promise gives our growing international student population an opportunity to participate in a program similar to the College's domestic student Guaranteed Job Program.

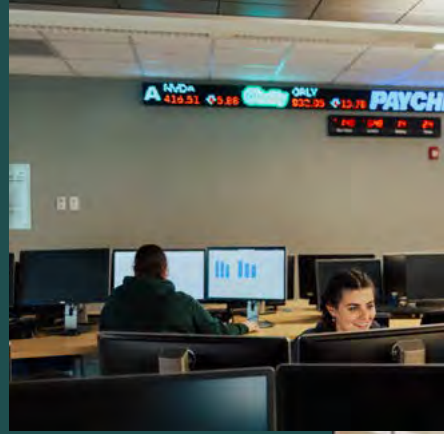
